The Jewish Community Center of Greater Pittsburgh's totally remodeled lunch program for seniors, held weekdays in Levinson Hall, Squirrel Hill, is being enthusiastically received by diners.

The new J Cafe, opened in October, provides kosher lunch in a cafe-style setting, and as a less institutionalized program, is attracting a broader group of seniors as well as JCC staff members and the community.

J Cafe, a program of the Allegheny County Area Agency on Aging, offers delicious lunch choices including hot entrees, deli sandwiches, soups and salads. The setting has been remodeled with cafe-style tables that promote social interaction, real dishes and silverware, easily understandable signage and welcoming energy efficient lighting. Hours have been expanded to 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. Special pricing is available for those ages 60 and older.

To accommodate the growing number of individuals attending the lunch, more than a dozen volunteers have been enjoying assisting in the program. Volunteers help those individuals who require special assistance.
